The south of the county has 7, problem 10km squares.

NS40 (4) Straiton – Dalmellington – Loch Doon; reasonable road access throughout.

NX08 (3/3) Benane head – Ballantrae; entirely coastal

NX18 (3) Colmonell – Pinwherry; short coastal stretch reasonable road access.

NX19 (6/10) Girvan south, coastal route; well served by road.

NX28 (5) Barrhill - large area of Galloway Forest Park, many good forest tracks.
